



Progress and Attainment of Learners

In May each year, children in Years 2 and 6 undertake Standard Assessment Tests (SATs) in Reading, Writing and Mathematics, and in Grammar, Punctuation and Spelling (GPS). These tests are administered in all primary schools across the country in order to measure the attainment and progress of learners, and to help Ofsted and prospective parents make judgements about the effectiveness of the school.
