

Weekly Overview—week beginning: Monday 8th January

Here is an overview of some of the activities we will be doing this week, in whole class and small groups.

Phonics

This week, we will be following Phase 4 of letters and sounds. The focus will be on reading and spelling cvcc words, as well as some high frequency words. Phase 4 will revise the letter sounds already covered in Phases 2 and 3.

English

This week, we will be looking at the story 'Lost in the Toy Museum' by David Lucas. We will be reading and retelling the story, focussing on the main characters in the story and imagining our own toys into the story.

Maths

This week, we will be looking at numbers to 40. We will be recapping the numbers to 20 and the children will practise representing these numbers on tens frames. We will be revising one more and one less, before moving on to represent larger numbers on tens frames.

Topic

Our new topic is Toys. We will be talking about our favourite toys and creating pictures of toys for a class display. We will also be thinking of ideas for toy related role play areas.

Handwriting

This week, we will be focussing on the letters:

V W X Z

We will focus on holding a pencil correctly, and forming the letters using the correct sequence of movements. We will also develop fine motor skills using playdough, tweezers and pens.
