

Monday 15th January to Friday 19th January

Here is an overview of some of the activities we will be doing this week.

Maths

This week, we will continue our unit on money. Children will add together pound notes and pence. They will also find different ways in which they can make a set amount of money, e.g. 28p = 20p, 5p, 2p, 1p; 28p = 20p, 5p, 1p, 1p, 1p and 28p = 10p, 10p, 2p, 2p, 2p, 2p. We will then compare different amounts of money, identifying which amount is larger, or if they are equal. Children will use the 'greater than, less than and equals' symbols (< > =).

Handwriting and Phonics

In phonics, we will be looking at the alternative spellings of the **ear** (clear), **ere** (here) and **eer** (cheer) sound.

In handwriting, we will be doing the letters: **x** and **z**

Our 'words of the week' will be: **are**, **our** and **love**.

Children need to be able to spell these by the end of the week.

English

In English, we will be continuing our unit of work based on '**Iggy Peck Architect**' by Andrea Beaty. We will write a letter to Iggy congratulating him on a new building he has designed. Children will learn about three different sentence types: **statements**, **commands** and **questions**. They will identify and then write a variety of sentence types in their letters.

Topic

This will be the last week of our Structures topic. Children will talk about their favourite parts of the school trip to Tower Bridge. They will then write a thankyou letter to David & Sophie – the Tower bridge tour guides. Finally, we will do a fun quiz to test what the children have learnt about structures.
