The Tudors

This half term, we will be learning about the Tudors. Tudor banquets (meals), were a lavish affair, sometimes with 35 different courses. Your task is to find out what the Tudors liked to eat and create a menu that Henry VIII would enjoy.

Can you have a go at making a Tudor mug? At Tudor banquets, kings and queens would always drink ale or wine. They would have one or two handles so they could 'cheers' their neighbouring diner. You could use junk modelling, papier mache, clay, etc. **Time—1 hour, some help may be needed.**
