Topic & science


Science—‘Animals including humans’. Within this topic the children will be finding out about the digestive system, the function and different types of teeth and also learning about producer, predators and prey.

Desert Island

Imagine being stranded on a desert island, with nothing but the clothes you stand in. What sort of shelter would ensure your survival? Your task is to make this shelter. It could be something you build in your garden out of natural materials, or a structure made from Lego or recycled containers.

Think about what would be available on a desert island and how you could use these materials for different purposes. You will then need to present your shelter to the class, through a PowerPoint, poster, 3D model etc.
