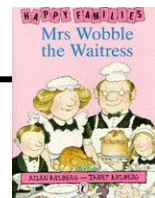
We will be reading lots of the Happy Families stories by Allan Ahlberg. Here are some activities you could try at home:

- Design a cover for your own Happy Families story. For example, you could make a cover for Ms Victoria the Vet or Mr Fred the Fashion Designer!
- Create a comic strip story involving your own Happy Family character.
- Make a character profile of your favourite character—think about your favourite characters from the stories e.g. Mrs Wobble the Waitress, Mr Buzz the Beeman. Could you draw a picture of this character and write a few sentences to describe him or her.



What happens next?

We have been reading Mrs Wobble the Waitress. At the end of the story, Mrs Wobble opens a successful café in her own house! What might happen next in the story? Can you tell your family what you think might happen in the next part of the story? Do they open more restaurants? Do they get any tricky customers? Does Mrs Wobble drop any more food?
