

# Year 2 Home Learning

## Topic & science

Our topic this half term is 'People of the Past: Victorians'. The children will be learning about what life was like in the Victorian era. We will be looking at the reign of Queen Victoria and some of the changes that occurred during her reign. We will be learning about explorers and inventions and talking about the British Empire.

## Proper Project

During the Victorian era, there were lots of discoveries, inventions and innovations. The people that were responsible for these exciting changes are now very famous!

Choose a famous Victorian and do some research about their life and discoveries. You could present your findings in a booklet, painting, factsheet or Power-Point presentation.

A famous Victorian invention is the telephone. Have a go at making your own string telephone. Experiment with different lengths of string, can you put more than two cups into your telephone system?
