Rule - If the root word ends with -ce, then the ending is usual spelt -cious e.g. <u>grace</u> becomes <u>gracious</u>.</p> <p>overcautious conscious vicious fictitious malicious</p> <p>Task – Make sure you know what each of these words means. Write a sentence using each. Try to practise using an imperative (bossy) verb to make an imperative phrase.</p>
