

Spelling focus for the week beginning: Monday 26th February

In this two week cycle, we will learn about two spelling rules:

- Words with the short /i/ sound, spelt **y**
- Words with the /k/ sound, spelt with **ch**

Example words:

Words with short /i/ sound spelt y - pyramid, myth, symbol, system

Words with /k/ sound spelt ch - school, echo, chemist, ache.

Over the two week cycle, the children will engage in different spelling and handwriting activities, linked to these spelling rules. They will collect various words over the cycle and write them into their word banks. These word banks are also stuck into their green spelling books ; you can encourage your child to find more at home.

As usual, they will bring home their own spellings to learn before their test. These words are mainly key words, but they may also link to the spelling rules we have been learning.

Remember to look at the word banks emailed home last half term to give you extra words to learn or to consolidate.
