Topic & Science

Topic: The Active Planet - this half term we will continue to find out about how the earth is formed and learn about specific natural disasters that made the history books!


Science: Sound - this half term we will learn all about sound, including how different sounds are made and how our ears are cleverly designed to hear sound.

Proper Project

When tectonic plates move against each other at boundaries, they cause earthquakes and eruptions of magma which form into volcanoes.

Create a large map of the earth on card or paper (ask your teacher if you need any resources). Draw and label the tectonic plates on your map. You can then create a key to show where the major earthquakes, volcanoes and tsunamis have occurred over the last 100 years.

As an extra challenge, research one particularly destructive earthquake, volcano or tsunami and write a news report about what happened.



Create 'n Make

Spring is coming; it is becoming warmer (slowly!), and the flowers are beginning to bloom. However, in some parts of the world, the next few months might be very different.

Choose somewhere around the world where you think the climate might be different to ours during our spring time. It might be much hotter or even completely frozen! Then, you are going to represent the two different climates and places as a piece of art.

You might want to create a collage, use photography, paint or create a 3D model of different flowers or animals. Get creative!
