

THE YEAR 6 WEEKLY OVERVIEW!

This page aims to give information about the subject areas that your child will be covering in their classes and in their English and Maths sets.

This information is for the week commencing: **12th March**

MATHS

Miss Bosworth's Set

This week we will be looking at simple formulae. We will consider various formulae and how they are expressed. We will solve missing number problems and simple equations, using our problem solving skills to help find the answers. We will also consider how formulae are used in different areas of maths.

Mr Shiel's Set

This week we will be looking at area, perimeter and volume. Children will explore how to calculate area of triangles and compound shapes. We will look at 3d shapes and learn how to calculate volume by using depth. Our times tables will be the 7x.

Mr Skrein's Set

This week we are looking at area, perimeter and volume. We will look at simple formula for finding the area of rectangles, triangles and parallelograms. We will also look at compound shapes. During the week we will also refresh out knowledge of \times , \div , $+$, $-$ fractions.

Miss Henry's Set

This week we will be looking at simple formulae and number patterns. We will look at how we can solve simple problems using a formula. We will also look at how to spot number patterns, how to describe these and how to predict later numbers in a pattern.

ENGLISH

Miss Bosworth's Set

This week we will continue our focus on Balanced Arguments. We will use the internet to add scientific weight to our arguments about whether we should ban plastic. In grammar, we will focus on cohesive devices and modal verbs, and in punctuation, parentheses. **Spellings: Year 6 word list**

Mr Shiel's Set

In English we will look at balanced arguments. We will focus on one issue this week: Robots. Children will read a range of views based around How much we should allow robots into our lives and What that looks like for jobs and society in the coming years. Spellings: Year six key words

Mr Skrein's Set

We will continue to look at balanced arguments and will focus on researching and presenting both sides of an issue. We are focusing on using formal language, cohesive devices and not being biased. **Spellings—homophones**

Miss Henry's Set

This week we will be revisiting some of our grammar work. We will be focussing on punctuation, recalling the names of the different types of punctuation and how to use them. Spelling— Year 6 word list

TOPIC

In WW2 we will look at a crucial turning point in the conflict: **Hitler's decision to invade Russia and fight a sustained campaign on two fronts. We will discuss how this impacted on the German war effort and stretched their resources and capabilities as an armed force.**

SCIENCE

In Science we will be looking at how the human ear works and how sound travels. Children will draw a detailed diagram of the ear and explain how we process sound.
