In your book, write some silly sentences and underline the spelling word, e.g. My cat likes to <u>sprinkle</u> glitter in the garden.</p>	<p>This week we are looking at the prefixes 'mis' and 'dis'</p> <p style="text-align: center;">misbehave disorder disappear misfortune disregard misjudge dislike mistake</p> <p>Task: Find out what the prefixes mis and dis mean. Try to think of some other words that have the prefix mis and dis.</p>
