

Year 4 Weekly Overview

This page aims to give information about the subject areas that your child will be covering in their classes and in their English and Maths sets.

This information is for the week commencing: **Monday 21st May.**

English

This week, we will complete our unit of work on **Stories with Fantasy Settings**. We will use the story '*Mouse, Bird, Snake, Wolf*' by David Almond as our stimulus.

The children will plan, write and edit an alternative ending for the story. They will think about the themes in the story so far, and how they can come up with a new ending that is still in keeping with the style of the story.

The language and grammar focus for this piece of writing will be sentence types. Children will be encouraged to use a range of sentence types in their work, including some complex sentences.



Maths

Ms Davies' set: This week, we will investigate the value of tenths and hundredths in numbers with two decimal places.

X Tables: **Turbo test**, with some missing sections!

Ms Noorani's set: We will use our understanding of division to find fractions of a number.

X Tables: division facts related to 11x table.

Ms Webb's set: We will look at the value of the whole and calculate fractions of amounts.

X Tables: **6x 7x 8x**

Mr Chamberlain's set: This week we will be investigating the value of tenths and hundredths in numbers with two decimal places.

X Tables: **Turbo Test** with some fractions

Ms Creamer's set: This week, we will look at equivalent fractions before moving onto addition and subtraction of fractions.

Topic

This week, the children will continue to design and plan a board game about the Greek Gods. They will work in small groups to allow teachers time to assess their group work skills.

Science

This week, children will learn about **classification** as a way of grouping living things. Children will be classifying plants and animals based on a variety of different factors.

RE

This week, children will learn why a shrine is a special place in a Hindu home. Children will be asked to think about their own special places and what makes them special.
