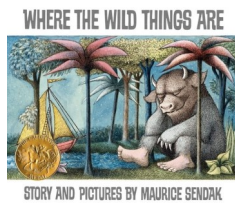
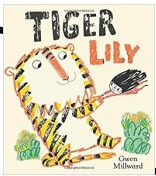
Take One Book

We will be looking at the natural world this half term with our topic of Flowers and Insects. Look for a story about the outdoors and have a go at some of these activities:

- Design a cover for your book. You might want to take a particular plant or insect as your theme.
- Create a comic strip story involving the main character from your story.
- Make a character profile of your favourite character—think about what your character likes or dislikes and where they might live.
- Write the next stage of the story, what will happen to the character after the story ends?



Poetry

Spend some time outdoors, take a thinking walk like Charles Darwin, and look carefully at what you see. Write a poem about what you see, hear, smell and touch in the outdoors.

What do the flowers smell like? What noises do the insects make? What do the plants feel like? How many species can you spot?
