

Monday 18th June to Friday 22nd June

Here is an overview of some of the activities we will be doing this week.

Maths

This week, we will continue our unit on **measures**. We will order containers based on their capacity size. We will then fill containers up to different capacities in millilitres. In the next lesson, we will make predictions about the capacity of different jugs and then add millilitres together. We will also read millilitre scales and record capacity accurately. Towards the end of the week, we will use thermometers to find the temperature of different things/places around the school.

Topic

We will think about the different types of holidays that we have been on, or could go on. We will then draw and write about things we would pack in our suitcase for two different types of holiday. We will also find out more about our World Cup teams!

English

We will finish our unit on 'Lucky Dip' this week. We will create a storyboard of the key events and then will verbally tell the story to each other, as well as act it out. We will then write the story in our own words. We will particularly focus on using interesting adverbs and a variety of sentence starters. We will go on to edit our writing and make improvements where necessary.

Music

In music, we will learn about orchestras in preparation for our trip. We will find out about the different sections of an orchestra and the instruments that are used. We will also look at the layout of an orchestra, along with continuing to practise the '**Mosquito**' song.
