MATHS

Miss Edge's Set

This week we will be focusing on place value. We will look at ordering numbers, including those with decimals, and rounding numbers to different degrees of accuracy. We will also solve a variety of number

Mr Shiel's Set

This week, we will be focusing on place value. We will create our own place value charts to help consolidate our knowledge. We will go on to order numbers, including those with decimals. We will do a times table test on

Mr Skrein's Set

This week we will be focusing on place value, which looks at how numbers relate to each other and their size. We will look at ordering number, including those with decimals and a variety of number

Miss Henry's Set

This week we will be looking at place value. This will involve ordering numbers and rounding numbers. We will be focussing on large numbers and decimals. We will then solve a variety of problems involving

Miss Webb's Set

This week we will be looking at place value—we will compare numbers of different sizes and work out what value each place holds, from units to millions. We will also begin looking at column addition.

ENGLISH

Miss Edge's Set

We will be starting our first unit of work looking at spooky tales. We will read and discuss a variety of scary stories, focussing on characters, and then write character descriptions that describes a character through their actions. Our grammar focus will be identifying different word types.

Mr Shiel's Set:

Our first unit of learning is SPOOKY TALES. We will be reading a series of scary stories and exploring how to weave vibrant description of a character into the action of a story. We will start by reading 'Gerald' by Chris Priestly and by exploring a range of unsettling characters from a variety of sources.

Mr Skrein's Set

We will be looking at spooky tales, this will involve looking at characters and writing a character description that implies aspects of a character through their actions and speech. Our grammar work will focus on word types.

Miss Henry's Set

This week we will begin our unit of work on 'Spooky Tales'. We will begin by coming up with our own spooky characters, building up a bank of descriptive words to help bring our characters to life. Our grammar focus will be noun phrases.

TOPIC

This week we will look at who runs Britain. We will discuss how governments are elected and when and why we shifted from a Monarchy to a Democracy. We will also touch upon what City Hall is in preparation for our trip.

SCIENCE

This week we will begin our science learning by looking at Forces. Children will be exploring the main types of forces that allow things to travel.
