Weekly Overview - Monday 1st October - Friday 5th October 2018

Here is an overview of some of the activities that will be happening this week.

Tanka, Tanka, Skunk!

This week, we will be reading 'Tanka, Tanka, Skunk' by Steve Webb. We will encourage the children to join in as they get to know the text. We will also be playing lots of games involving clapping the rhythm of the text and the syllables of the words, and asking the children to have a go at clapping the syllables in their own name.

Maths

We will be spending some time this week exploring Numicon. This is a fantastic resource that we use a lot at school for developing children's understanding of number. It can be used in a variety of ways and it is very colourful and tactile.

Letters and Sounds

This week, we will be listening to sounds in the environment and practising identifying individual sounds at the beginning of words, by playing games like 'I-spy'.

We will also focus on the letter sounds **s** and **a**, finding things and looking at some words beginning with these sounds.
