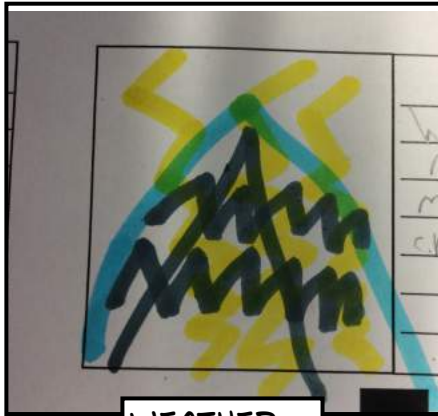


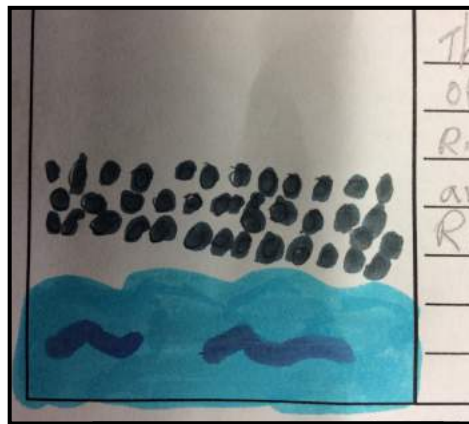

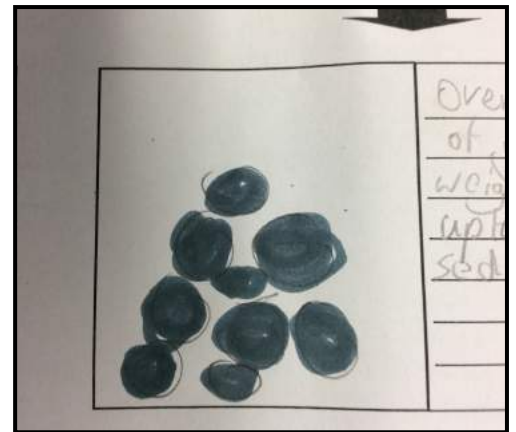
SEDIMENTARY

ROCKS.

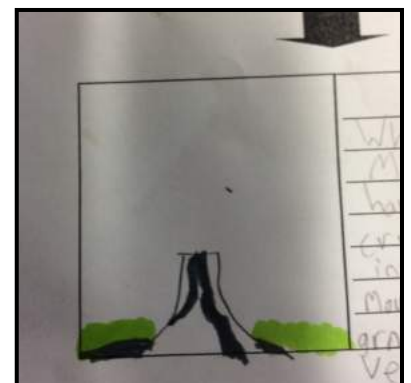
IGNEOUS
