



## Progress and Attainment of learners at Coleridge

In May each year, children in years 2 and 6 undertake Standards Assessment Tests in Reading, Writing and Mathematics, and in Grammar, Punctuation and Spelling (GPS). These tests are administered in all primary schools across the country in order to measure the attainment and progress of learners, and to help Ofsted and prospective parents make judgements about the effectiveness of the school.

Below are Coleridge's results for tests undertaken in May 2019:
