## Spring

We are beginning to talk about the change of season and what we will expect to see around us in Spring. We will be finding out about Spring flowers and also about animals which are born at this time of year. We will also be discussing Easter and how people celebrate Easter.

### Create 'n Make

As Spring approaches, people often start to spend more time outside in gardens, parks and woods.

Talk to people at home, look on the internet and in books to find out about things we can do to help keep our local environment clean.

Can you collect some different things we can recycle and use them to make something? You could make a collage picture, a model, or even a poster about helping our world?

### Physical Development

Did you know that the Government has said that children in Reception should be physically active for at least 3 hours each day? This helps you to stay fit and healthy, and doing physical activities should also be fun! Choose a day and write down or draw a picture of all the physical activities you do that day. Activities could include going for a walk, cycling, taking part in a playground activity or a sport of your choice. Did you



complete your 3 hours? Can you think of any ways you could spend longer doing physical activities each day?

### Let's talk...

Think about outdoor spaces you like going to such as a park or woods. Where's your favourite place? Maybe it's somewhere local, or somewhere further away. Why do you like going there? Talk to someone at home about what makes it special and how people can look after it.

### Out and about...

Go for a walk to some local woods or the Parkland Walk. Can you see any signs that Spring is on its way? You may want to take a photo or sketch some of the things you see. Look out for crocuses, snowdrops, and daffodils. What other signs of Spring can you spot?
