### To the parents,

Each week, we will be sending **English** and **Maths** remote learning activities for your child to do at home. A **Wider Curriculum** activity sheet will also be sent home every few weeks.

Compiling these has been a challenge for us - we are fully aware that you have the unenviable task of doing your jobs, helping your children with school work, as well as being parents. With that in mind, we tried to provide activities where few resources are needed and a printer isn't required. Most activities simply require a pencil and paper. We also tried to ensure that many of the activities can be done with some degree of independence. You may have to support your child in starting what they are doing, but we then hope they can finish it on their own.

It is really important that your child continues to read every day for 10 minutes. We also really want them to learn the 6 spellings each week. In Year 2, for writing and maths, we have given 5 lessons a week. We hope that this doesn't cause you worry or panic; instead we hope it makes it simple and clear what could be done each day. A typical week of learning could look like this:
