

How the 'Tidy Your Bedroom Machine' Works

Keeping one's bedroom tidy can be a real issue for children and result in a great deal of conflict and bad feeling between young people and their parents. How can one solve this difficult problem? Well a 'Tidy Your Bedroom Machine' can do this. This is an explanation of how it works.
