Sometimes, **c** makes an /s/ sound. Let's say these examples:

slice

When the grapheme 'c' is before an 'e', 'i' or 'y', its sound is soft and it makes the /s/ sound.






They followed the ginger cat to a door in the wall. The cat went inside. "The next clue must be in here," said Sam as they walked towards the door.






c Cup Sort

To get the next clue, Kit, Sam and Asim must sort the jewelled cups into **c** saying /c/ and **c** saying /s/ words.









Sentence Time
