

### Lesson 3 - I can work out durations of time.

Question	Answer and workings
<p>Nyah leaves for school at 10 past 8. It takes her 35 minutes to walk. What time does she arrive at school?</p>	
<p>Alex goes on a 45 minute cycle ride. He leaves at 10 to 4. What time does he get home again?</p>	
<p>A cake takes 70 minutes to bake. If we put it in the oven at 3:00pm, what time will it be finished?</p>	
<p>Mr Ibbotson starts his parkrun at 9 o'clock. He finishes at 20 past 9. How long does it take him?</p>	

<p>Ms Creamer takes her dog out for a 30 minute walk. They get back home at 5 to 7. What time do they leave to start their walk?</p>	
<p>Ms Ibbotson starts setting up her classroom at quarter past 4. It is ready at 10 past 5. How long does it take her to set up?</p>	
<p>Some children play football in the park after school. Their game lasts for 50 minutes. It finishes at 25 past 4. What time does the game start?</p>	
<p>Golden Time finishes at 10 past 3. The children spend it watching a film for 40 minutes. What time does Golden Time begin?</p>	

<p>Josh watches his favourite TV show. It starts at 4 o'clock and finishes at quarter to 5. The adverts in the middle last for 5 minutes. How long is the TV show?</p>	
<p>Rishi and Ellie were playing outside. Rishi played for a quarter of an hour. Ellie played from 4 o'clock until half past 4. If Rishi finished 5 minutes after Ellie went out to play, what time did he start playing?</p>	
<p>Isabelle can swim 2 lengths of the pool every 5 minutes. She starts swimming at 10 past 9 and finishes at 5 to 10. How many lengths does she swim?</p>	
<p>Ben, Louise and Kate are playing hide and seek. They start playing at quarter past 11. They play for 45 minutes before stopping for a drink and a biscuit. They continue to play for another 45 minutes before going back home at 10 past 1. How long did they spend having their drink and biscuit break?</p>
