It has been lovely seeing the children this week and getting back into some sort of routine. Remote learning

This will continue for the rest of the term. We will be explaining what we are teaching in school, and giving suggestions for other activities that can be done at home. We have tried to make it clear which activities we are doing at school, so if your child is coming into school you do not need to do these activities.

Phonics

We are continuing to upload daily phonics PowerPoints and PDFs. We will also be doing these at school. If your child is in Bubble A, we will teach lessons 1 and 2 on Monday and Tuesday, so you can continue with the rest of the lessons that week. If your child is in Bubble B, we will teach lessons 4 and 5 on Thursday and Friday, so you can do the other lessons before they come into school that week.

English

Over the next few weeks we will be doing some non-fiction writing about insects. At school, we will be labelling the different parts of an insect and writing some sentences to describe them. At home we suggest your child goes on a bug hunt to see what different insects they can find.

Maths

We are continuing with multiplication and division in maths. We have suggested some different activities for your child to do when they are at home, along with some videos to watch and websites to look at.

Zoom

Each class will be having a zoom meeting at some point over the next couple of weeks so that we can all see the whole class. It will be when either Bubble A or Bubble B are at school. If your child is not at school on the day that we are doing the zoom chat then they can join us from your home. We will email you soon with more information.
