Dear Parents,

Last week, I sent out a survey to see who would like their child to attend Nursery if we opened before the summer. Thank you to everyone who responded. Due to the amount of parents saying yes to the survey, I am now working to create 'bubbles' based on the days you requested. I will try my best to accommodate these requests but it may not always be possible. I will be sending more information about your child's place in the next few days.

Once the groups have been organised we will not be able to accommodate any more children or allow children to move from one group to the other. Children using key worker provision will not be able to use both groups and will need to stay in their Key worker group or Nursery group.
