








Today, we are learning to read and write words that contain **tch** saying /ch/.




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Let's practise reading some of this week's focus words that contain the **tch** sound.







After reading Hansel and Gretel in school, we decided to dress up as a witch and wizard. We used the magic book to go and find a real witch.




We found ourselves in Hansel and Gretel's house. They said that they needed our help because a witch called Patch was trying to catch them.




We discovered that we had magical powers! Sam made it so that we could not be seen and Kit used his magic to tip Patch's spell all over the floor.
