

Year 2 Remote Learning

To the parents,

We are so looking forward to welcoming some of the children back this week for a couple of sessions in school. You should have received an email with details of your child's bubble and other important information. If you have not received this, please email your child's class teacher and they will send it directly to you.

For the three days that your child is not in school and for those children who are not able to come into school, we have set English and maths remote learning lessons. In **English**, the children will be writing a letter to their new teacher and in **maths**, they will be looking at patterns. As most children will be coming to school this week there will be no Zoom calls taking place.

If you require a paper copy of this week's remote learning lessons and resources, please email your child's class teacher at year2@coleridgeprimary.net. They will then arrange for a pack to be printed off for you to collect from the school office on East.

Important information - please read:

Reading books:

The school is collecting in all the reading books during the week beginning 6th July. Please could you return any reading books that you have got at home. If your child is coming into school they can bring it in during the week and give it to their class teacher. If your child is not coming into school, we would really appreciate it if you could drop the books off in the box which is by the East school office. We are asking for any Oxford Reading Tree books, chapter books and books that have been borrowed from other children in the book swap. We also ask that you return any school library books that you may have at home.

Year 2 bubbles - items to bring:

Please could all children bring in a water bottle and a piece of fruit (optional) to school on the days they are in. Unfortunately, we are not able to supply fruit as normal, but we are still planning on having a short break from activities to have a story and a chat, so children may want a piece of fruit during this time.

The 2nd day your child will be in, is their last day in school before the summer holiday. We will be sending all their work from Year 2, PE kits and other belongings home with them at the end of the day. Please could all children bring in a bag to put their things into on either Tuesday or Friday, depending on which bubble they are in.

Transition to Year 3 booklet:

One of the activities we have planned for the children whilst they are in school is to make a 'Moving to Year 3' book with them. We often make these transition books for children who are feeling particularly nervous about the change to another year, to take home with them over the summer holiday. Owing to the strange and unsettling circumstances we all find ourselves in, we have decided it would be beneficial for all children to make one of these books. These books will go home with the children and we encourage you to read them with your child, especially if they are feeling nervous or worried about coming back to school in September.

If your child is not coming into school, your child's class teacher will make a book for them and email it to you for you to read at home together.

New class teacher:

You will now have heard who your child's class teacher will be next year. All teachers have made a video message for their new class, and we shall be showing these to the children when they come into school. We will also be sending links to these videos so those children not coming into school can watch them too.
