Geography, History and Science

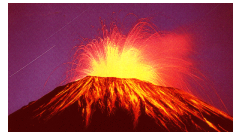
Geography: Volcanoes. Within this topic, we will find out about volcanoes, what causes them, some famous active and dormant volcanoes, and the impact of them.
