Dear Parents and carers,

Welcome to the final half term of Year 4! We're excited to get stuck into some interesting teaching and learning with the children, as well as preparing them for their transition into Year 5.

Here are our topics for these final weeks:

English: Poetry: We will be studying poems from 'Dancing in the Rain' by John Lyons.

Maths: Money, Position and Direction, Statistics

Science: 'All living things' – This will involve learning about different animals and plants and thinking about how they are suited to their habitat. Some of this content was covered as remote learning earlier in the year.

History: Continuation of 'Alexander the Great,' making links to previous learning about ancient civilisations.

Geography: 'Earthquakes', followed by 'Coastal Processes'.

Music: 'Living Together.' This unit includes listening, singing and composition.

ICT: This half term, we will be doing some typing lessons with the children, as well as a simple coding project.

PE: Dance – all children will learn and perform a routine for the summer performance of A Midsummer Night's Dream.

PSHE: This half term, all classes will complete three lessons around relationships and health education, and three lessons around drugs and alcohol education. These lessons teach children about some very important aspects of the curriculum, such as maintaining a healthy body, knowing about their bodies and how they change during puberty, and staying safe. At Coleridge, we have been teaching children about these subjects for many years, so there is no change to our curriculum, although relationships education is now a statutory part of the curriculum for all primary schools as of September 2020.
