Fair Play's qualified, kind and caring staff provide affordable wrap-around care exclusively for pupils at Coleridge School.

After school, children are accompanied to one of three premises, depending on their age.

Fair Play staff collect infant children from their classrooms. Juniors meet us in the playground.

Breakfast Club for Infants is based on site at Shirley Boffey House

Breakfast Club for Juniors (year 3 and above) is off site at Edison road.

Fair Play's Holiday Club is for all ages is based on site at Shirley Boffey House.

Many parents are entitled to help with fees, using Gov.uk Tax Free childcare or existing voucher systems used by employers that allow you to pay for childcare before you pay tax on your earnings. The childcare element of Universal Credit can also help.

We accept all childcare vouchers.

Fair Play can offer (subject to availability) a few ad hoc/emergency places every day (both before and after school) for children who are pre-registered with us by parents who may need wraparound care at short notice.

TERM-TIME ACTIVITIES

After school, children can enjoy a healthy snack, rest, play with friends and have the opportunity to join a wide range of activities. These include art, craft and painting, cooking, skittles, Lego, drama and dance, clay, woodwork, knitting, sewing, reading, table football, cards, chess, board games, puzzles, table tennis, air hockey and different sports.

We provide both club-based activities and fun outings such as day camping, skating, horse riding, bowling, trips to the cinema, park and seaside, and visits to museums and art galleries.
