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<b>YEAR 5</b>	<p>In this unit, children will take part in a series of lessons where they will:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>develop an understanding of families, including marriage;</li> <li>understand what to do if someone feels unsafe in their family;</li> <li>learn that dealing issues can strengthen a friendship;</li> <li>explore the impact of bullying and what influences a bully's behaviour;</li> <li>learn to appreciate our individual positive attributes.</li> </ul>	<p>In this unit, children will take part in a series of lessons where they will:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>learn to take greater responsibility for sleep, sun safety, healthy eating and managing feelings,</li> <li>learn how to set goals,</li> <li>learn how to embrace failure;</li> <li>understand the importance of rest and relaxation.</li> </ul>	<p>In this unit, children will take part in a series of lessons where they will:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>explore the emotional and physical changes of puberty, including menstruation;</li> <li>learn about online safety;</li> <li>learn about influence;</li> <li>learn strategies to overcome potential dangers;</li> <li>learn how to administer first aid to someone who is bleeding.</li> </ul>	<p>In this unit, children will take part in a series of lessons where they will:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>have an introduction to the justice system;</li> <li>learn how parliament works;</li> <li>learn about the role of pressure groups;</li> <li>learning about rights and responsibilities;</li> <li>learn about the impact of energy on the planet;</li> <li>find out about how to contribute to the community.</li> </ul>	<p>In this unit, children will take part in a series of lessons where they will:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>develop an understanding about income and expenditure, borrowing and risks with money;</li> <li>explore stereotypes in the workplace.</li> </ul>	<p>In this unit, children will take part in a lesson to prepare them for the transition to Year 6 and the opportunities and responsibilities this brings.</p>
