

Year 2 Home Learning

Topic & science

Our topic this half term is **The Stone Age**. Children will learn what the terms **ancestors**, **prehistoric**, **hunter gatherers**, and **nomadic** mean. They will learn about **cave paintings**, **Stonehenge** and how homes were built.

In science, we are learning about **animals including Humans**.

Create 'n make

Research what tools were used in the Stone Age and then make your own. Think carefully about what materials would be available to someone who lived then. Think about what your tool would be used for.

History

Invent an outfit for a cavewoman or caveman to wear. You could draw, paint or use collage. Think carefully about what materials would be available during the Stone Age.

Physical Activity

What physical activities do you do every day? Maybe you walk to school, enjoy skipping or play ball games. Did you know that the Government has said that children should be physically active for at least 60 minutes each day? This helps you to stay fit and healthy, and doing physical activities should also be fun! Your task is to complete a physical activity diary for one week during this half term. Activities could include going for a walk, cycling, taking part in a playground activity or a sport of your choice. Once you've completed your log, bring it into school to share with your class.

Science

Animals have offspring which grow into adults. Choose an animal you like and research its life cycle. Then create your own **life cycle** for that animal.
