Curriculum

We started our first units of work for both maths and English this week. More information about the content of these can be found in the **Weekly Overview**, which will be put on to Parent Hub every Friday afternoon. We encourage you to look at this so that you can talk to your child about what they are doing each week, and support their learning in these areas where possible.

English – this is taught in class and the weekly overview will provide more information each week. Spellings will be sent home weekly in your child's spelling book, and spelling tests will take place every Friday.

Maths – will be taught in sets. A brief overview of the areas of learning for each week will be on the Weekly Overview.

History – 'The Maya', this topic focuses on the creation of the city in 750 CE.

Geography – 'Cities', focusing on the causes, impact and efforts to address drought in the region. **Science** – 'Animals, Including Humans'

Computing – 'Online Safety & The History of Computers'

Religions and world views - 'How People Express their Views'

D&T – 'Textiles'

PE – Jason Bichri and Mario Vitrano will be teaching each class once a week. The class teachers will also be teaching their class PE.

Art – this is taught by Gemma Curtis every fortnight.
