Topic & Science

This half term, our topic is 'Knights and Castles'. We will be learning about our likes and dislikes, our families, parts of the body, and what makes each of us special.

Make your own castle using a box. Think about what features your castle is going to have. Is it going to have a tower, a drawbridge, a moat, arrow slits, a gatehouse, a flag?

When you have made your castle, take a photograph of it and either bring the photo into school or ask an adult to email it to your teacher.
