

# Year 2 Home Learning

## Topic & Science

Our topic this half term is **Weather around the World**. This is a **geography** topic. We will find out which continent different countries are in. We will compare the weather and other features of different countries. We will learn about different climates.

In science, we are learning about **animals including Humans**.

## Proper Project

Design a hotel!

Choose a geographical location and design a new and unusual hotel. You could look at some existing hotels for inspiration: an ice hotel, treetop hotels, or Giraffe Manor. Think about the weather, what people might like to do there, and how you want the hotel to look. Also consider a theme - what will the staff wear? What will the rooms look like?

## Weather

Pick a country and research what the weather is like there. You could create a presentation about the weather, or perhaps a table with the average temperature for each month.

## Physical Activity

What physical activities do you do every day? Maybe you walk to school, enjoy skipping or play ball games. Did you know that the government has said that children should be physically active for at least 60 minutes each day? This helps you to stay fit and healthy, and doing physical activities should also be fun! Your task is to complete a physical activity diary for one week during this half term. Activities could include going for a walk, cycling, taking part in a playground activity or a sport of your choice. Once you've completed your log, bring it into school to share with your class.

## Science

Animals have offspring which grow into adults. Choose an animal you like and research its life cycle. Then create your own **life cycle** for that animal.
