Create 'n Make

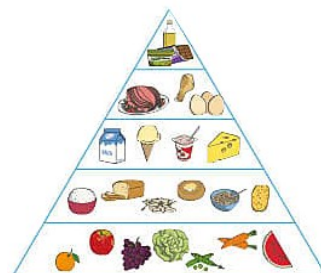
Research what tools were used in the Stone Age and then make your own. Think carefully about what materials would be available to someone who lived then. Think about what your tool would be used for.
