

# Year 2 Home Learning

## Topic & science

This half term, our topic will be ***Our local area: Crouch End***. This will be a Geography topic, with a particular focus on understanding and drawing maps. In science, we are learning about ***Living Things and their Habitats***.

## Proper Project

In class, we are going to be drawing **bird's-eye view** maps of our school, and of the local area. We want you to draw a bird's-eye view picture of a room in your house. Think carefully about where all the items in the room are and how big they should be in your drawing.



## Create 'n Make

Make a 3D model of an area in Crouch End. This could be the clock tower, Dunn's bakery or a row of shops. Include a road or pavements so that it becomes a 3D map.

## Out and about...

We are going to learn about **human** and **physical** features in our local area. **Physical features** are anything natural, such as nature and landforms. **Human features** are anything human made. Take a walk around your local area. Can you make a list of all the physical and human features that you spot? You could even take photos of the different things that you see and sort these into physical and human features back home.

## Let's talk...

Lots of people are worried about the school and local area being polluted. How can we make our school and local area greener? What changes could we make?

## Science

You could visit the woods or the Parkland Walk. Have a look under fallen branches and leaves to see what is living there. You could take a photo or draw a picture of what you see.
