Reading

Please remember to bring in your child's reading bag (complete with the 2 reading books and 1 library book) on their designated book swap day, this information can be found displayed in your classroom window. We are unable to send home new books if the previous ones are not returned. We will be reading with every child each week in small guided reading sessions as well as 1-2-1 over the half term.

Louise Foulkes, our school Deputy Head and Reading Lead, has posted some *bitesize* 'how to' guides to support parent/carers with reading. They are short videos that you can watch in your own time to understand our ethos around reading at Coleridge, how phonics is taught and useful tips and ideas

Cooking

Start and end of the day

For security reasons, we lock the classroom doors to register the children at 8.50am. It can be very disruptive for children who have already been dropped off if there are parents/children still at the door at this time, so please say goodbye and leave by 9am so that we can ensure a calm start to the day for all children. If you arrive at school after 8.50am, please register your child at the office

Please make sure that your children do not play with the resources and equipment in the Reception playground after school has finished.

Very important information

Medical conditions & food allergies/intolerances - it is vital that we have accurate information about any medical conditions or food allergies/intolerances your child may have. Please report any changes to the school office.

Contact details - on several occasions, when trying to contact some parents/carers if their child is unwell or has had an accident, we've been unable to get hold of anyone, usually because mobile numbers have been changed but we have not been notified. Please make sure you have informed the office of any changes to your contact details.

Absence – for safeguarding reasons, it's essential that you inform the school of the reason why your child is not in school. If your child is going to be absent, you can either phone the school, email admin@coleridgeprimary.net or register the absence on ParentHub.
