Create 'n Make

Make your own shadow puppet

What you need:

- Lamp
- Cardboard
- Sellotape
- Pencil
- Scissors
- Skewer/stick
- White wall

How to:

- Choose a puppet to make. This could be your favourite animal, a character from a story you like, or even you or one of your friends or family.
- 2. Draw the outline for your puppet on the cardboard and cut it out.
- 3. Use sellotape to attach a skewer/stick to the back of your puppet.
- 4. Put the lamp on the floor or on a table. Point it at the wall and turn it on. Turn off other lights and close the curtains.
- 5. Hold your puppet between the light and the wall. Can you see a shadow on the wall? Move the puppet between the light and the wall to make the shadow different sizes. How do you make the shadow bigger? Smaller?
- 6. Now you can act out a show!
