Make your own castle using a box. Think about what features your castle is going to have. Is it going to have a tower, a drawbridge, a moat, arrow slits, a gatehouse, a flag?

When you have made your castle, take a photograph of it and either bring the photo into school or ask an adult to email it to your teacher.
