Year 1 Newsletter - February 2025

Dear Parents/Carers,

We hope you all had a lovely half term. We have some great learning planned for the rest of the spring term.

Curriculum

This half-term, we will be starting a new **geography** unit on 'The Rainforest'. We will be looking at where there are rainforests in the world and what their features are. We will look at the different animals that live in rainforests - focusing on Borneo, the Amazon and the Congo. Finally, we will learn about deforestation.

Our **science** topic, 'Everyday Materials', continues for this term as well as looking at 'Seasonal Change'. This will link in with both our English and geography units.

In **English**, we will be focusing on the books 'The Umbrella' and '10 things that I can do to help my world' this term. We will also be focusing on Poetry. Please see the **Weekly Overviews** for more detail.

In **maths**, we will start the unit of work 'Numbers to 50'. We will be learning to count to and across 50, forwards and backwards, beginning on any number; to count, read and write numbers to 50 in numerals; to count in multiples of twos, fives and tens; and to identify one more and one less. We will also be focusing on 'Measures' where we will be learning about length, weight and capacity.

In **phonics**, we will continue learning the phase 5 sounds. Please see the weekly overview to see which sounds we are learning each week as well as tricky words. We will also continue to send home spellings every Friday and will have a spelling quiz every Friday. The spellings will be on the weekly overview.

In **music**, our unit of work is 'Our World'. We will be learning to play simple rhythms with a steady beat, to compose simple musical patterns and to use symbols to represent sounds.

We are continuing our **religion and worldviews** unit of work 'How do we celebrate our journey through life?' and continue to talk about how people celebrate important events in their lives.

Our next Personal Social Health Education (**PSHE**) unit of work will be 'Safety and the Changing Body' after we finish off our 'Health and Wellbeing' unit with learning about allergies, people who keep us healthy and sun safety.

In **PE** we will be focusing on gymnastics and games for this half-term. <u>Please ensure that your child is coming to school dressed appropriately in their PE kits on their PE days. They can wear shorts, leggings or tracksuit bottoms and will need to be wearing trainers. If your child has long hair, please ensure it is tied back.</u>
