- If your child has a condition which requires medical treatment then it is your responsibility to ensure that information on the school health register, and medicines kept in school, are up to date. These medicines will be taken on school trips and administered as per the care plan if required.
- The school also keeps contact information for all parents and carers, which will be used to contact you in an emergency. It is your responsibility to ensure that the information you have given to the school is correct. If you are unsure, e-mail or speak to staff in the school office.
