Stay and Play Sessions

This half term we will be holding our first stay and play session. This will be a chance for you to spend time in the Nursery with your child, playing and exploring with them. We will have two sessions, one in the morning (9-9.45am) and one in the afternoon (2-2.45pm). Unfortunately, we cannot accommodate all parents at the same time so there will be an equal number of slots available for both of the sessions. The date for our first stay and play will be on **Wednesday 4th February**. A message will be sent in the next few weeks with details of how to sign up. If you can't make it, please don't worry as there will be more stay and play sessions throughout the rest of the year.

At this age, children can struggle to communicate when or how they have injured themselves. If your child has an injury at home, especially ones to their head or face that are visible, please let a member of the Nursery team know at drop off. This will help us identify much easier if a child has hurt themselves at Nursery and we can support them accordingly.
