Dear Parents and Carers,

Welcome back! It has been lovely to see the children again after the Easter break ready for the final term of year 6.

Curriculum

More detailed information about the content of English and Maths lessons can be found in the **Weekly Overview**, which is put on to Parent Hub every Friday afternoon. We encourage you to look at this so that you can talk to your child about what they are doing each week, and support their learning in these areas where possible.

English – We have started a new unit which will lead to a piece of writing about animal written in the style of an animal documentary.

Maths – We will be finishing our unit on shape, then we have two units left before SATS: Position and direction and statistics.

History – ‘World War II’

Geography – We will be completing our unit on Birmingham before starting a new topic: Jamaica.

Science – ‘Evolution and Inheritance’

Computing – ‘Capturing Evidence’ and ‘Bletchley Park’. This is taught by Jason Bichri every fortnight.

Religions and world views – ‘What do People Believe?’

PE – Taught by class teachers and Mario Vitano

Art – this is taught by Gemma Curtis every fortnight.

PE

This half term all classes will have a squash lesson once a week as one of their PE lessons. Days and classes:

Tuesday afternoon: 6O and 6B

Friday afternoon: 6P and 6R

Children need to wear their PE kit on their PE days. This should be loose fitting clothing and trainers. Children may have to miss their PE lesson if they are not wearing appropriate clothing.
