#### 1. Chair's update:

- a. The Active Challenge has raised £2,000 from children's sponsorship (around 30 participants) and £250 in sponsorship from Rise. This initiative cost us zero to put on, and David Astburys printed the flyers for us. The money goes into the playground pot, and next year could be extended to more of a concerted effort at bringing groups together and more of a campaign.
- b. The Community Gardening monthly sessions bring out a range of volunteer skills and can take on lots of tasks to repair, beautify, improve and green the school site, so it's becoming more key to our outdoor masterplan.

#### 2. Treasury updates:

- a. Team appointments: Chair proposed Steven Shenton who's applied to be the new Treasurer, based on his relevant skills and experience, noting



his motivation and positive approach. COMMITTEE APPROVED THE APPOINTMENT OF NEW TRUSTEE IN THIS ROLE. Chair noted that parents Nathaniel Mead and Clare Loftus-Ruder are also in discussion for sharing the Treasury duties, Trusteeships TBC. Handover begins Thursday 11th June 8pm.

- b. Trustees report and accounts to file are drafted for the Charities Commission, independent review planned.
- c. We'd like to have a meeting with the new Treasury team and any Committee Members interested in reviewing our financial position and having a strategy and forecast discussion - date TBC.

### 3. Reps and RepCo recruitment:

- a. NC proposed Lorena Andrill-Young as the new coordinator and the Committee approved this appointment, Trusteeship TBD.
- b. After half term, confirming Class Reps begins.
- c. Chair to set-up a Reps briefing kickoff session for September.

### 4. Y6 fundraising updates: the disco and the parties are organised. Discussion of shortfall in School Journey costs and how to support the school in making this trip accessible.



5. Reception new cohort welcome:

- a. Book bags CF intro flyer being created, GN to chase Jo for the order of these and add the flyers.
- b. Noted that classroom visits are scheduled for new parents of RO & RB on Tues 7 July, RR & RP on Thurs 9th July, both at 4pm. GN plus at least one Committee Member will run refreshments and stall at these, poll to follow on availability
  - i. This means moving our Volunteer Reward Tea, GN to check Mon 29th June, Weds 1st July or 13th July with school.
