Dear Parents and Carers,

We hope that you all had a wonderful half term, we can't believe how quick this year has gone! In the next few weeks, we will start to talk to the children about transitioning to Reception. For those children who will be attending Coleridge, we will be taking them to the Reception classrooms to become familiar with the environment near the end of the term. They will also get to spend some time with their new teacher, once they have been allocated to a class.

### **Reception Places**

During this half term, the EYFS lead will be putting together classes for Reception (with input from the Nursery team). As you can imagine, with 120 children starting in September, there is a lot of information that they will have to consider when putting the classes together. Therefore, we can't always guarantee that your child will be placed with all of their friends. However, as the Nursery team know the children so well, we will ensure they have some of their friends with them in the same class. There will be about 10 children from the Nursery in each class so your child will be surrounded by lots of familiar faces! Later on in the term, you will receive information from the school on who your child's new teacher will be. Please be aware, requests for your child to be in a certain colour class cannot be considered.

### **Nursery Sports Day and party**

We are planning to hold our Nursery Sports Day on Thursday 9<sup>th</sup> July. This will take place in the afternoon from 1.30pm in the school grounds. Following the sports event, we would like to invite you all back to the Nursery for a summer picnic party which will be finished by 3pm. We will send more information nearer the time. We hope that you can all make it!

### **Clothing and Sun cream**

With sunny weather hopefully here to stay, we would suggest sending your child in to Nursery with a sun hat. We also have a basket in the office where we keep sun cream; if you would like your child to wear sun cream, please bring some in with your child's name clearly written on the bottle. We would also advise applying sun cream before your child comes to Nursery.
