History & Science

Our topic this half term is **The Stone Age**. Children will learn what the terms **ancestors**, **prehistoric**, **hunter gatherers**, and **nomadic** mean. They will learn about **cave paintings**, **Stonehenge** and how homes were built. In science, we are learning about **Everyday Materials**.

Research what tools were used in the Stone Age and then make your own. Think carefully about what materials would be available to someone who lived then. Think about what your tool would be used for. Make sure you have your grown ups' permission!



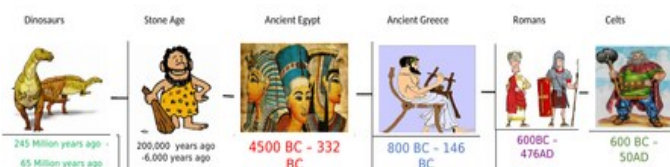
History
