Dear Parents and Carers,

We hope you all had a nice break. Here we are, the final half term!

This is what we are focusing on this half term:

English – We will be reading the book ‘Goodnight Mr Tom’ which is set during World War 2. We will be reading and discussing the story, writing diary entries, character descriptions and newspaper articles amongst other things. We will also watch parts from the film to supplement the reading.

Maths – We will be going over key concepts that our different classes need work on and then focusing on some projects that involve the children drawing on their maths skills in more investigation projects.

History – We continue with our topic on ‘World War II’

Geography – After completing our unit on Jamaica, we have a final topic called ‘Comparing three regions’.

Science – We will be completing our topic on ‘Evolution and Inheritance’ before starting a unit about Living things.

Computing – ‘Capturing Evidence’ and ‘Bletchley Park’

Religions and world views – ‘What do People Believe?’

Art – this continues to be taught by Gemma Curtis every fortnight.

PSHE – Alongside our usual PSHE lessons we will be doing lots of talking about the transition to secondary school. We will also have our unit on Puberty, reproduction and relationships this half term. We will give you more specific information about the lesson contents and when these are happening in our weekly overviews.

PE - Children will need to wear their PE kit on their PE days. This should be loose fitting clothing and trainers. Children may have to miss their PE lesson if they are not wearing appropriate clothing.
